

RGB Foundational Workshop

This 2-hour workshop enables participants to learn more about their own thinking patterns and the patterns of those with whom they work and share their life. The result is always a long-lasting insight that benefits the participant as well as those they influence. There are always plenty of take-home materials as well as a comprehensive online library for those who desire to explore more deeply into these profound learnings.

*Completion of the online RGB Inventory in advance is recommended.**



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OUTCOMES:

1. Learn valuable insights about yourself that are often masked.
2. Improve the effectiveness of participants as they interact with others.
3. Learn to spot and correct conditions that might otherwise lead to undesirable conditions.
4. Provide the online resources that will allow gaining more insight in specific areas of interest.

AGENDA:

1. Participants immerse themselves in a highly competitive simulation that dramatically demonstrates real-life behaviors. Behaviors that provide a constant undercurrent that inhibits progress toward goals. The learning achieved in this short simulation is second only to the guaranteed hysterical fun!
2. Brief Lecturettes describe the thinking patterns and behaviors as a means of beginning the recognition process of each primary color pattern. Participants begin to immediately "type" themselves into one of the prime colors. Questions and answers refine an understanding of each pattern.
3. Three subgroups are formed; one for each primary color pattern. Participants get to choose which group they think most strongly represents their own style. Observations of color groups as they form through self-selection are encouraged and discussed.
4. Each subgroup completes an assignment to strengthen their understanding. One member is selected to brief out their findings to all participants.
5. The final dialog discusses the implications of applying this new-found knowledge on two levels: immediately in the remaining conference time available, and upon return to their home stations.
6. As the time together draws to a close, participants complete an evaluation, and receive Certificates of Completion of Phase 1. This time is also used to identify those who may opt to pursue online Study Guides to become Certified in the use of the RGB Technology.
